CAP. XXXIV.

An Act to repeal an Act, intituled An Act to prevent illicit and Clandestine Trade, and for imposing a Duty upon Articles illegally imported or brought into this Province, to be levied and paid after the Condemnation and Sale thereof.

Passed 31st March 1831.

BE it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Forty seventh Year of the Reign of King George 17 Geo. 3. c. 16. the Third, intituled An Act to prevent illicit and clandestine Trade, and for imposing a Duty upon Articles illegally imported or brought into this Province, to be levied and paid after the Condemnation and Sale thereof, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CAP. XXXV.

An Act to amend an Act, intituled An Act to repeal all the Acts now in Force relative to the Importation and Spreading of infectious Distempers in the City of Saint John ; and to make more effectual Provisions for preventing the same.

Passed 31st March 1851.

'WHEREAS by the Seventh Section of an Preamble. ⁴ Act made and passed in the Tenth and Elev- 10 & 11 Geo.4, ⁴ enth Years of the Reign of His late Majesty ^{6, 27.} 'King George the Fourth, intituled An Act to ' repeal all the Acts now in Force relative to the ' Importation and Spreading of infectious Dis-' tempers in the City of Saint John; and to make 'more effectual Provision for preventing the 'same, the Mayor, Aldermen and Commonalty, ' in Common Council convened, are empowered ' to order and direct the landing of Passengers ' from Vessels whilst performing Quarantine, in 'order to facilitate the Recovery of those who ' are
