An Act to continue an Act passed in the Second Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act to empower the Owners of the Saw 2 W. 4. C. 5. Mill at the Rolling Dam on the River Digdeguash, in the County of Charlotte, to erect a Boom for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River .

Passed 22d March 1834.

EE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Second Year of the Reign of His 2 W. 4.C. 5, present Majesty, intituled An Act to empower Continued. the Owners of the Saw Mill at the Rolling Dam on the River Digdeguash, in the County of Charlotte, to crect a Boom for the securing of Saw Logs on the said River, be and the same is hereby continued, and declared to be in Force, until the First Day of February which will be in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and forty.

CAP. XI.

An Act to continue an Act passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King George the Fourth, intituled An Act to repeal 9 G. 4. C. 28. all the Laws now in Force for the Appointment of Firewards, and for the better extinguishing of Fires in the Town of Saint Andrews, and to make Regulations more suitable to the said Town, and for other Purposes therein mentioned.

E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act passed in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His Majesty King 9 G. 4. C. 28, George the Fourth, intituled An Act to repeal all Continued. the Laws now in Force for the Appointment of Firewards, and for the better extinguishing of Fires in the Town of Saint Andrews, and to make Regulations more suitable to the said Town, and for other Purposes therein mentioned, be and the same is hereby continued to be in full Force for Six Years.
