Masts, Logs and Lumber in certain Parts of the County of Northumberland, be and the same is hereby continued, and declared to be in full Force until the First Day of May which will be in the Year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and thirty nine.

## CAP. VIII.

An Act to explain the Act for preventing the Importation and Spreading of infectious Distempers in the City of Saint John.

## Passed 22d March 1834.

WHEREAS Doubts have arisen whether Preamble. "the Second, Third, Fourth and Fifth Sections of an Act made and passed in the Third Year of 3. W. 4. C. 21, 'His present Majesty's Reign, intituled An Act 'to prevent the Importation and Spreading of ' Infectious Distempers in the City of Saint John, · are applicable to the Cases of Vessels arriving in or near the Harbour of Saint John, or in the Bay of Fundy, at any other Period of the Year · than between the First Day of May and the First ' Day of November in every Year ;'

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Go- 3. W. 4. C. 21, vernor, Council and Assembly, That the Prohi-S. 2. 34 and 5, extended to bitions, Restrictions, Directions, Penalties, and herein described Inflictions in the said Sections contained, shall Vessels arriving at Saint John, and are hereby declared to be applicable to all or in the Bay of Cases of Vessels arriving in or near the Harbour Fundy during any Part of the of Saint John, or in the Bay of Fundy, during any Year. Part of the Year, having on board the Small Pox. Yellow Fever, or other Pestilential or Contagious Distemper, or coming from any Port or Place infected with any such Distempers, or at or near which any such Distempers, at the Time of their Departure, were known or supposed to prevail, or on board of which said Vessels any Person or Persons, during the Voyage, had been sick or had died of any such Distempers.
