

CAP. XV.

An Act to continue an Act, intituled "An Act to regulate the Assize of Bread in the Towns of Newcastle and Chatham in the County of Northumberland." 1 W. 4, c. 37.

Passed 25th March 1840.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the first year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act to regulate the Assize of Bread in the Towns of Newcastle and Chatham, in the County of Northumberland," be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force and effect until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five. 1 W. 4, c. 37, continued.

CAP. XVI.

An Act to continue an Act in addition to the Laws now in force for the protection of the Fisheries in the Counties of Northumberland, Kent and Gloucester.

Passed 25th March 1840.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the seventh year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled "An Act in addition to the Laws now in force for the protection of the Fisheries in the Counties of Northumberland, Kent and Gloucester," be and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force and effect until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and forty five. 7 W. 4, c. 23, continued.
