ANNO DECIMO TERTIO VICTORIÆ REGINÆ.

CAP. XIV.

An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace of the County of Charlotte to levy an assessment to pay the County Debt and contingent expenses of the said County.

*Passed 11th April 1850.*

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace of the County of Charlotte, at any General Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden therein, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding one hundred and seventy five pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary, for the purpose of paying off the debt and the contingent expenses of the County; the same to be assessed, levied, collected and applied agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for the assessing, collecting and levying of County Rates.

Assessment authorized to pay off the County debt and contingent expenses.
