CAP. XVII.

An Act to enable the Justices of the Peace for the County of Northumberland for the time being to receive the title of and hold a piece of Land in the Town of Newcastle, for the use of a Grammar School in the said Town.

Passed 26th April 1850.

THEREAS it is desirable that the title to the piece or parcel of Land Preamble. ' situate in the Town of Newcastle, in the County of Northumberland, 'hereinaster described, should be vested in the Justices of the Peace for the 'aforesaid County, in trust for the use of a Grammar School in the said Town;'
