ANNO DECIMO TERTIO VICTORIE REGINE.

CAP. XX.

An Act to alter and amend the Act incorporating the Carleton County Agricultural Society. Passed 26th April, 1850.

THEREAS in and by the Act of the General Assembly, eleventh Victoria, Preamble. chapter fifty four, incorporating the Carleton County Agricultural Society, 11 V e 54.

' it is provided by the second section of the said Act that the general meeting of the

members of the said Corporation, for the election of Officers, be held on the Mon-

day next before the last Tuesday in September in each and every year, which ' period is found to be inconvenient: And Whereas it is deemed advisable that such

' election should be held at a later period of the year, to enable the Board of Officers

' to close the business of such Society for the past year before others are appointed ' in their stead:'

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and General meeting of the Corporation to be held on second members of said Corporation for the election of Officers, as provided by the second Tuesday in December. section of the said Act, shall be held on the second Tuesday in December in each and every year.

II. 'And whereas at a general meeting of the members of said Corporation Officers elected to continue in office theld at Woodstock on the Monday next before the last Tuesday in September 'last, one President, two Vice-Presidents, a Treasurer and Secretary, were elected appointed. ' by the votes of the said members for the current year;' Be it enacted, That the said Officers so elected as aforesaid shall continue in office until the second Tuesday in December next, or until others are chosen in their stead, any thing in the said Act to the contrary notwithstanding.
