CAP. XVII.

An Act to incorporate the County of Kent Agricultural Society.

Passed 30th April 1851.

THEREAS certain Farmers and other inhabitants of the County of Kent Preamble. ' did in the vear one thousand eight hundred and fifty, form themselves ' into a Society for the encouragement of Agriculture in the said County, and

' they are desirous of being incorporated to enable them more effectually to carry

'out the objects of the said Society:'

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council Company incorporated by the name and Assembly, That J. G. G. Lavton, John Carruthers, D. M'Almon, John Main, of The County of J. C. Wheton, C. W. Weldon, Honorable John W. Weldon, David Wark, W. Society, Brait, John Clark, Thomas Johnson, William Doherty, William M'Leod, L. P. W. Desbrisay, George Pagan, Lawrence M'Larren, John Power, Edward Powell, J. R. Creelman, Sylvanus Powell, Thomas Stennison, John Potter, James Mooney, John Mooney, and James M'Phelim, their associates and successors, be and they are hereby declared to be a Body Corporate, under the name and style of The County of Kent Agricultural Society, for the encouragement of Agriculture, and for this purpose shall have and enjoy all the powers made incident to Corporations by an Act of the General Assembly of this Province made and passed in the sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King William the Fourth, intituled An Act to prescribe certain general regulations in respect to Corporations.

II. And be it enacted, That there shall be a general meeting of the said Cor- An annual meeting to be held on the poration annually holden on the second Monday in January in each and every second Monday in January, when vear, at Richibucto, in the said County, at which meeting there shall be chosen office bearers shall be chosen. by a majority of the members, one President, two Vice Presidents, one Treasurer, two Secretaries, and twelve Directors, who shall continue in office one year or till others are chosen in their room, in the choice of which each member of the

Corporation shall have one vote for each of the aforesaid officers.

III. And be it enacted, That the officers chosen at a general meeting of the said Society, holden at Richibucto aforesaid, on the second Monday in January continue in office the said Society or Corthogon the said Soc poration till the second Monday in January next, or till others are chosen in their

stead.
