CAP. II.

An Act to authorize Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County of Gloucester to assess the said County to pay off the County Debts.

Passed 15th March 1851.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That Her Majesty's Justices of the Peace for the County of Gloucester, at any General or Special Sessions of the Peace hereafter to be holden, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make such rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding five hundred pounds, in such sums and at such times as they in their discretion may think necessary, for the purpose of paying off the debts of the said County; the same to be levied, assessed, collected and paid agreeably to any Acts now or hereafter to be in force for assessing, collecting and levying of County Rates; provided that any Special Sessions of the Peace to be holden for that purpose, under the provisions of this Act, shall consist of not less than five Magistrates.

Assessment not exceeding £500, to pay off the County debt, authorised.
