CAP. II.

An Act to incorporate the Woodstock Farmers and Mechanics' Library Society.

Passed 15th March 1851.

DE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, Farmers and That the Farmers and Mechanics' Library Society now established and located at the Upper Village of Woodstock, in the County of Carleton, for the purpose of Woodstock, incorprocuring Books on Agricultural, Mechanical, Historical, and other subjects, to form a Library for the use of the Members of the said Society, be incorporated; and that Joseph Harvey, Senior, James H. Brodrick, William Wiley, Ralph Ketchum, James Edgar, Asahel M. Brodrick, Anthony Kearney, Wingate Weeks, Lewis P. Fisher, David Munro, and such other persons as are or may become Members of the said Society, shall be and are hereby constituted a body corporate for that and no other purpose, by the name aforesaid, with all the general powers and privileges incident to Corporations by Act of Assembly of this Province; provided always, that the real Beat Estate to be estate which the said Corporation may at any time hold shall not exceed in value postessed limited one thousand pounds.
