BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assem- Each Parish, bly, That at the annual meeting for electing Town or Parish Officers in interested in the I. | the County of York, there shall be elected in each Parish of the said County, Alms House, to connected with and interested in the Alms House and Work House, except the sioner.
