CAP. VIII.

An Act to amend an Act relating to the repairing of the Streets and Bridges in a part of the Parish of Saint Stephen.

Passed 28th March 1851.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That instead of two shillings and six pence in lieu of each day's labour required by an Act passed in the fourth year of the present Reign, intituled *An Act to provide for more effectually repairing the Streets and Bridges in a part of the Parish of Saint Stephen*, the sum of one shilling and three pence only in lieu of each day's labour shall in future be required, and that the scale of labour shall be the same as that established by the seventeenth section of an Act passed in the thirteenth year of the present Reign, intituled *An Act relating to Highways*.

Money rate established by Act 4 V. c. 10, in lieu of labour, reduced to 1s. 3d. per day.

Scale of labour to be as in Act 13 V. c. 4.
