An Act to alter and amend an Act, intituled An Act to incorporate the New Brunswick Society 13 V. c. 62. for the encouragement of Agriculture, Home Manufactures and Commerce throughout the Province, and to regulate and provide for the same.

Passed 28th March 1851.

THEREAS it is deemed expedient to make the Grant allowed by the Preamble. 'above mentioned Act to the New Brunswick Society for the encour-'agement of Agriculture, Home Manufactures and Commerce throughout the 'Province, to the extent of two hundred pounds, on similar terms as to County 'Agricultural Societies, and to alter the time for transmitting the proceedings of ' the said Society to the Provincial Secretary from the first Thursday in January

CAP. IX.

THEREAS it is considered expedient to repeal a clause contained in Preamble. ' the Table of Colonial Duties and Exemptions from Duties in the 'Act of Assembly made and passed the present Session, intituled An Act for 'imposing Duties for raising a Revenue;'

I. Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council Act 14 V. c. 5, and Assembly, That so much of the said recited Act as is contained in a certain clause of the Table of Colonial Duties and Exemptions from Duties, mentioned in the said recited Act, in the words following, that is to say:--" All articles of "which any component part or parts is or are subject to Duty, to be liable to the "highest rate of Duty to which any one of the said component parts will be liable

"under this Act," be and the same is hereby repealed.
