CAP. IX.

An Act to alter and amend the fifth section of an Act, intituled *An Act to consolidate the Laws* 13 v. c. 9.  
*relating to Buoys and Beacons*, so far as the same relates to the County of Restigouche.

Passed 28th March 1851.

**B**E it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly,  
That such part of the fifth section of an Act, intituled *An Act to consolidate  
the Laws relating to Buoys and Beacons*, as relates to the Bays or Harbours of  
Restigouche, be and the same is hereby repealed, and in lieu thereof, that from  
and after the passing of this Act, one penny per ton be collected from all vessels,  
as therein specified, entering the said Bays or Harbours of Restigouche, any law,  
usage or custom to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.

One penny per ton  
on shipping enter-  
ing the Bays or  
Harbours of Resti-  
gouche to be paid.
