CAP. XVIII.

An Act relating to the Public Wharves in the Parish of Portland in the County of Saint John. Passed 18th February 1852.

Preamble.

X7HEREAS the great increase of business and travelling has rendered 'it necessary that all the Public Wharves in the Parish of Portland 'should be laid out and established as Public Highways, and recorded as such, ' and thereby power given to the Commissioners of Highways for the time being ' to keep such Public Wharves free from obstructions;'

Commissioners of Highways to have the same authority over Wharves as over Public High-

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council and Assembly, That it shall and may be lawful for the Commissioners of Highways for the time being, in and for the Parish of Portland, to lay out, record and establish all Public Wharves and the Approaches thereto in the said Parish, as Public Wharves and Approaches, and to keep them at all times free from obstructions, and shall have the same power and authority in respect thereof as is by Law vested in them in respect of any other Public Highway; provided always, that such Wharves and Approaches shall not be of a less width than twenty feet, any Law to the contrary notwithstanding.

THEREAS Henry Tye, Robert Atcheson, George M'Kay, Archibald 'M'Callum, James Brown, Charles Carson, Matthew Stevenson, the Reverend John S. Thomson, the Reverend William Millan, Nehemiah Hill,
