CAP. I.

An Act to appropriate a part of the Public Revenue towards the Patriotic Fund.

Section.

1. Grant in aid of Patriotic Fund.

2. To be drawn by Warrant.

Passed 9th February 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. That there be granted and paid out of the Treasury of this Province, to His Excellency the Licutenant Governor, the sum of five thousand pounds, in aid of the Patriotic Fund.
- 2. The said sum of money shall be paid by the Treasurer of the Province by Warrant of the Governor in Council out of the moneys now in the Treasury.

CAP. II.

An Act imposing Duties for raising a Revenue.

Section.

- 1. Duties as in Table to be collected
- 2. To be in addition to any other Daties.
- 3. Duties remitted on Goods for the deep sea or whole fishery.
- 4. Weights and Measures.
 5. Goods in "Table of Exemptions" free.
- 6. Duty on Goods of several component parts.

- 7. Certain articles may be admitted Duty free by Proclamation.
- 8. What, Act not to interfere with.
- 9. Cap. 14, Rev. Stat., and 17 V. c. 19, re-
