An Act authorizing the sale, by the Bishop of Fredericton, of certain lands in Harvey, in the County of Albert, for the purposes of the Church in that Parish.

1. Authority given to sell Church land at 2. The Bishop's deed to be a good title.

Harvey corner.

Passed 12th April 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly, as follows:—

- 1. The Lord Bishop of Fredericton is hereby authorized and empowered to sell and convey such portion of the lot of land at Harvey corner, in Harvey, County of Albert, upon which the Episcopal Church is now erected, as is not required for the said Church; the proceeds of said sale or conveyance to be appropriated towards the liquidation of any debts incurred in the erection of said Church.
- 2. The deed or conveyance given by the said Lord Bishop under the provisions of this Act, shall have the effect to convey a good and sufficient title to the purchaser or purchasers, his or their heirs and assigns.

CAP. LVI.

An Act to authorize the sale of Glebe lands in the Parish of Moncton.

Sale of part of Glebe of Saint George's Church, Moncton, and reinvestment, authorized.

Passed 12th April 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry of Saint George's Church, in the Parish of Moncton, in the County of Westmorland, be and they are hereby authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of all or any part of the Glebe Lands in the said Parish, for such price or prices as they may be able to obtain therefor, and thereupon to make and execute good, legal, and sufficient conveyances of the same in fee, and to invest the proceeds the eof in other lands, or in the erection of a Parsonage for the use of the Rector of the said Church, and his successors; such conveyance to be valid only upon being signed by the Lord Bishop of Fredericton, or his consent endorsed thereon.
