2. The amount arising from such sale shall be invested by the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, in the purchase of other freehold estate, more conveniently situated for the benefit of the Rector of said Church, to hold the same to the said Rector, Church Wardens, and Vestry, for a Glebe for the use of the Rector of said Church for the time being.

CAP. LXII.

An Act relating to the Saint Stephen Railroad Company.

Time for completing Railway extended.

Passed 12th April 1855.

BE it enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—That the times mentioned in the eighteenth Section of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of Her present Majesty's Reign, intituled *An Act to incorporate the Saint Stephen's Railroad Company*, for completing the two different Sections of the said Railroad, shall be and they are hereby respectively extended and continued to the first day of May one thousand eight hundred and sixty six.

CAP. LXIII.

An Act in addition to an Act intituled *An Act to Incorporate the Nashwaak Boom Company*.

Section.

1. Unmarked logs to be sold weekly; distribution of proceeds.

Section.

2. Limitation of Act.

Passed 12th April 1855.

WHEREAS great quantities of logs not having any mark or other index of property, are oftentimes found within the precincts of the Nashwaak Boom Company, and it is expedient that the disposal and appropriation of the same should be regulated by law;—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Legislative Council, and Assembly,—

1. That the Nashwaak Boom Company, on every Monday during the rafting season in each year, between the
