26 George III – Chapter 16

An Act for Establishing a Tender in all Payments to be Made in this Province

Whereas it is necessary for the ascertaining of contracts, to determine the value of the coin in which all tenders may be lawfully made.

II. Be it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly, That an English guinea shall pass current and be received for twenty three shillings and four pence, and a silver English or French crown piece for five shillings and six pence, and all other English gold and silver coin in the like proportion, and that Spanish mill'd dollars shall pass current and be received for five shillings each, and a half joannes, for forty shillings, in all payments to be made within this province.
