

Acts of the General Assembly of His Majesty's Province of New-Brunswick passed in the year 1786. Saint John, NB: J. Ryan, 1786.

26 George III – Chapter 8

A Bill entitled an Act for enabling the Justices of the Supreme Court to try all causes at Nisi Prius and authorizing Attorneys of the Supreme Court to practice in the inferior courts of Common Pleas within this province.

Be it enacted by the Governor, Council and Assembly That the justices of the supreme court, or any of them, shall have full power and authority to hear and determine in the several and respective circuit-courts, which shall from time to time hereafter be for that purpose appointed in the province, all causes brought to issue in the supreme court, without a commission being expressly made for that purpose.

And be it further enacted, That all and every of the Attorneys of the supreme court, may commence, prosecute, or defend any action or suit for his or their clients in any inferior court of common-pleas within the province.
