28 George III – Chapter 7

An Act in Addition to an Act, intituled, “An Act for Regulating Pilots”

Whereas there are no Justices of the Common Pleas yet appointed for the County of Northumberland, and the act for regulating Pilots cannot therefore be carried into execution in that County,—and Whereas, it is expedient that some regulations should be made respecting Pilots in that County.

Be it Enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That until Justices of the Common Pleas shall be appointed in the County of Northumberland, the Justices of the Peace in the said County shall be, and hereby are vested with the same powers and authorities within the said County, as by the said Act for regulating Pilots is therein given so the Justices of the Common Pleas, in their respective Counties.
