32 George III – Chapter 8

An Act to enable the Justices of the Court of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas in King's County to hold the same Courts for the present Year at the Time therein mentioned.

Whereas the Court of General Sessions of the Peace and Inferior Court of Common Pleas in King's, county have not been holden in this present year on the second Tuesday in February as by law appointed: And whereas it is expedient that the same Courts should be holden as soon as conveniently may be, for the purpose of transacting the business of and arising in the said county, which might or ought to have been done and tranfacted on the said second Tuesday in February in this present year.

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That the said Courts shall be holden in this present year on the third Tuesday in March instead of the said second Tuesday in February, any law or ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding.

II. And be it further enacted, That no writ or process of any kind whatever shall abate or be discontinued by reason of the same courts not having been holden on the said second Tuesday in February as aforesaid – but that all writs and processes which were returnable on the second Tuesday in February shall be proceeded upon in the same manner as if the same were made returnable on the said third Tuesday in March; and that all other business of what nature or kind soever that ought to have been done on the said second Tuesday in February, shall and may be done and proceeded upon on the said third Tuesday in March, and shall be valid and effectual to all intents and purposes as if the same had been done and proceeded upon on the said second Tuesday in February.

III. And be it further enacted, That after the said third Tuesday in March, the times of holding the said courts shall be and remain as already by law established, that is to say, on the second Tuesday in February and the first Tuesday in July in every year any thing herein contained to the contrary notwithstanding.
