35 George III – Chapter 7

An Act further to continue an Act intituled “An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province.”

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an act made and passed in the thirty third year of His Majesty's reign, intituled “An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province,” and by an act, made and passed in the thirty fourth year of His Majesty's reign intituled “An Act to continue an Act intituled, “An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province,” declared to be continued in full force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Five and no longer; be further continued: And the same is hereby continued in full force until the first day of April which will be in the year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety Six, and no longer; except for the recovery of any of the penalties inflicted in and by the sixteenth Section of the said act.
