36 George III – Chapter 3

An Act to Revive and Continue an Act intituled “An Act for Preserving the Bank of the River Saint John in Front of the Parishes of Magerville [Maugerville], Sheffield and Waterborough.” Passed the 12th March, 1796.

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an act intituled “An Act for preserving the Bank of the River Saint John in front of the Parishes of Magerville, Sheffield, and Waterborough” made and passed in the thirty fourth year of His present Majesty's Reign, be revived and continued; and the same is hereby revived and continued, and declared and enacted to be in full force for the term of five years, and no longer.
