39 George III – Chapter 4

**An Act to provide for payment of the Services therein mentioned. Passed the 8th February, 1799.**

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That for the purpose of defraying the Debts of this Province, for the year one thousand seven hundred and ninety-five, there be paid out of the monies now remaining in the Treasury, the following sums, to wit: – To William Pagan, Esq. for Books imported by order of the House of Assembly, for the use of the Legislature, the sum of twenty four pounds three shillings and four pence: To Thomas Wetmore, Esq. for services performed by him in preparing sundry Bills and other assistances of Clerk-ship rendered the House of Assembly, the sum of ten pounds.

II. And be it further enacted, That the aforesaid sums of money, shall be paid by the Treasurer by Warrant, issued by the Lieutenant Governor or Commander in Chief of this Province, for the time being, by and with the advice and consent of His Majesty's Council, and the receipts of the several persons intitled to the said sums, indorsed on the said Warrants, shall be to the Treasurer good vouchers and discharges for so much as shall thereby be acknowledged to be received.
