41 George III – Chapter 10

An Act to continue an Act, intituled "an Act for preserving the Bank of the River Saint John, in front of the Parishes of Maugerville, Sheffield and Waterborough." Passed the 21st of February, 1801.

I. Be it enacted, by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act, intituled "an Act for preserving the Bank of the River Saint John, in front of the Parishes of Maugerville, Sheffield and Waterborough," made and passed in the thirty-fourth year of His present Majesty's Reign, be continued: And the same is hereby continued, and declared and enacted to be in full force for the term of Four Years and no longer.
