41 George III – Chapter 11

An Act to empower the Justices of the Peace for the County of York, to make such regulations respecting the Winter Roads in that County as may be found necessary. Passed the 16th of February, 1801.

I. Be it Enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, the Justices of the Peace for the County of York in their General Sessions be, and hereby are authorized and empowered to make such rules and regulations, as they may judge necessary respecting the public Winter Roads in the said County. And further that the said Justices may affix such penalties not exceeding twenty shillings for each offence, as they may think necessary, for carrying into execution such rules and regulations so by them to be made and established.

II. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall continue and be in force for the term of Three Years and no longer.
