41 George III – Chapter 7

An Act to continue an Act made and passed in the thirty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "an Act for regulating, laying out and repairing Highways and Roads, and for appointing Commissioners and Surveyors of Highways within the several Towns or Parishes in this Province, and for suspending for a limited time all the Laws now in force relating to the same." Passed the 21st of February, 1801.

I. Be it Enacted by the Lieutenant Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the thirty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "an Act for regulating, laying out and repairing Highways and Roads, and for appointing Commissioners and Surveyors of Highways within the several Towns or Parishes in this Province, and for suspending for a limited time all the Laws now in force relating to the same" be continued; And the same is hereby continued, and declared to be in full force for the term of Five Years and no longer.
