43 George III - Chapter 4

An Act, in addition to an Act, intitled "an Act for the better ascertaining and confirming the Boundaries of the several Counties within this Province and for subdividing them into Towns and Parishes." Passed 16th March, 1803.

- I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That a direct line from the northwest corner of the County of Westmorland, until it meets the southwest branch of Miramichi river, where the Portage leading from the river Nashtcaak [Nashwaak] now joins the same, thence by a line running north twenty-two degrees thirty minutes west by the true meridian from the junction of the said Portage, with the said southwest branch of the Miramichi as aforesaid, to the southern boundary of the Province of Lower Canada, shall be deemed the boundary line of the County of Northumberland, and the dividing line between that and the adjoining Counties.
- II. And be it further enacted, That the Island of Campo-Bello, [Campobello] with its appurtenances, in the County of Charlotte, be constituted a distinct Town and Parish, by the name of the Town and Parish of Campo-Bello; any Law or Ordinance to the contrary notwithstanding.
