45 George III – Chapter 17

An Act to Continue an Act made and passed in the Forty-third Year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province." Passed the 5th of March, 1805.

Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Forty-third year of His Majesty's reign, intituled, "An Act for railing a Revenue in this Province," be further continued, and the said Act and every clause, matter and thing therein contained, is hereby continued and declared to be in full force until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord, One thousand Eight hundred and Seven.
