47 George III – Chapter 15

**An Act to make perpetual sundry Acts of the General Assembly which are near expiring. Passed the 5th of March, 1807.**

Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Twenty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act for relief against absconding debtors" — Also an Act made and passed in the Twenty-eighth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act, in addition to an Act intituled an Act for relief against absconding debtors" — Also an Act made and passed in the Twenty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act to regulate the sale of Goods at Public Auction Or Outcry" — Also an Act made and passed in the Twenty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act to prevent fraud in the sale of damaged Goods imported into this province" — Also an Act made and passed in the Twenty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign entitled: "An Act to authorize the respective proprietors of certain Islands in the River Saint John, and other Rivers in this Province, to make rules and regulations for their better improvement and cultivation" — And an Act made and passed in the Twenty-eighth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled "An Act to empower the Justices of the Sessions in several Counties in this Province to make such rules and regulations respecting Markets and Ferries within such Counties as may be found necessary" — be, and the same are hereby made perpetual.
