48 George III – Chapter 3

An Act to alter and amend an Act, intitled "An Act for regulating Marriage and Divorce, and for preventing and punishing Incest, Adultery and Fornication." Passed the 30th of July, 1808.

Whereas in and by an Act made and passed in the thirty first Year of His Majesty's Reign, intitled "An Act for regulating Marriage and Divorce, and for preventing and punishing Incest, Adultery and Fornication," it is enacted that the fixed and stated Terms of holding the Court of Governor and Council for the purposes and causes therein mentioned, shall be, and commence on the first Tuesday in February, and the third Tuesday in July in each and every year: And whereas it is expedient to alter the commencement of one of the said Terms.

I. Be it therefore enacted, by the President, Council and Assembly, That from and after the first day of January next, the fixed and stated Terms of holding the said Court of Governor and Council for the purposes and causes in the said herein before recited Act mentioned, shall be, and commence on the first Tuesday in February, and the first Tuesday in July in each and every year, any thing in the said herein before recited Act to the contrary thereof in any wise notwithstanding.
