An Act, to continue an Act, intituled "An Act to prevent illicit and clandestine Trade, and for imposing a duty upon articles illegally imported or brought into this Province, to be levied and paid after the condemnation and sale thereof. Passed the 14th of March, 1810

Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act passed in the forty-seventh year of His Majesty's continued to the Reign, intituled "An Act to prevent illicit and clandestine Trade, and for imposing a duty upon articles illegally imported or brought into this Province, to be levied and paid after the condemnation and sale thereof," be, and the same is hereby continued to the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and fifteen.
