50 George III – Chapter 14

An Act to continue and amend an Act, intituled "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province." Passed the 14th of March, 1810.

I. Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the forty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled " An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province and since continued to the first day of April next; be, and the same is hereby farther continued (excepting wherein the same is herein' amended and altered) and declared to be in full force, until the first day of April, which will be in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twelve.

II. And be it further enacted; That no drawback whatever, on any duties shall be hereafter allowed on any Rum, Wine, Brandy, Gin, or brown Sugar, exported from this Province, and landed at any port or place in the United States to the eastward of Machias harbour.
