

Acts of the General Assembly of His Majesty's Province of New-Brunswick passed in the year 1810. Saint John, NB: Jacob Mott, Printer to the King's Most Excellent Majesty, 1810.

50 George III – Chapter 24

An Act to authorise the Justices of the Peace in their General Sessions, to establish Ferries in their respective Counties. Passed the 14th of March, 1810.

Whereas it is often found difficult for travellers in passing to the different parts of the Province to cross rivers and creeks for want of proper establishments of Ferries.

Be it therefore enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That the Justices in their General Sessions of the Peace for each County, shall be, and are hereby authorised and empowered to establish such Ferries over rivers, bays, and creeks; within their respective Counties, as may be by them thought necessary in places where the same are not already established by grants from the Crown. Provided always, that this Act or any thing therein contained, shall not extend, or be construed to extend to restrain, or any wise affect the right of the King's Majesty, his Heirs and Successors, to make any grant or grants of any Ferry or Ferries, in places where the same may be found necessary. Provided also, that this Act shall continue and be in force six years and no longer.
