50 George III – Chapter 26

An Act in addition to an Act, intituled “An Act for the more effectual prevention of desertion from His Majesty’s Forces.” Passed the 14th of March, 1810.

Whereas an Act, made and passed in the forty-fifth year of His Majesty’s Reign, intituled “An Act for the more effectual prevention of desertion from His Majesty’s Forces,” has provided that the rewards to be given for apprehending deserters, shall not in any one year exceed one hundred pounds: And whereas From the augmentation of the number of troops, since the passing of the said Act the said sum of one hundred pounds has been found in some instances insufficient for the purpose of giving the rewards for apprehending all the deserters.

Be it therefore enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly That the said sum of one hundred pounds, mentioned in the said Act, be increased to the sum of one hundred and fifty pounds; that the rewards so to be given out of the Province Treasury may amount to, but shall not in any one year exceed the said sum of one hundred and fifty pounds.
