50 George III - Chapter 29

An Act to revive and continue sundry Acts of the General Assembly, that have expired. Passed the 14th of March 1810.

Be it enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for preserving the bank of the River Saint John, in front of the Parish of Lincoln, in the County of Sunbury." Also, an Act made and passed in the forty-first year of His Majesty's Reign; intituled "An Act to continue an Act "for preserving the bank of the River Saint John, in front of the Parishes of Maugerville, Sheffield and Waterborough" be, and the same are hereby revived and declared to be in full force for six years and no longer.
