50 George III – Chapter 8

An Act in addition to the Act to prevent the encumbering or filling up of Harbours. Passed the 14th of March, 1810.

Whereas in and by an Act, made and passed in the thirty-third Year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to prevent the encumbering or filling up of Harbours" no person is appointed to sue for the penalties therein mentioned. Be it therefore enacted by the President, Council, and Assembly, That it shall be the duty of the Port Wardens of the respective Ports, in which such offences may be committed, to sue for, and prosecute for the recovery of the said penalties, and any one of such Port Wardens is hereby authorised and required to prosecute for such penalties, and when recovered to apply the same in manner, as in and by the said Act is directed.
