56 George III – Chapter 29

An Act to continue and amend the several Acts now in force for raising a Revenue in this Province. Passed the 16th of March, 1816

I. Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the forty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province," and also an Act in amendment thereof, made and passed in the fiftieth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to continue and amend an Act, entitled 'An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province,'" and also another Act in amendment of the said two Acts, made and passed in the fifty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to continue and amend the Act for raising a Revenue in this Province, and the Act in amendment thereof," and also an Act made and passed in the fifty-third year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act for the farther increase of the Revenue of this Province," and also an Act made and passed in the fifty-fourth year of His Majesty's Reign, entitled "An Act to give full effect to, and to prevent the evasion of an Act, entitled 'An Act for the further increase of the Revenue, of this Province,'" and also another Act made and passed in the same year, entitled "An Act for laying additional duties on certain articles imported into this Province" be, and the same Acts are hereby continued and declared to be in full force, except wherein the same, or any of them are herein-after amended and altered, until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventeen.

II. And be it further enacted, That in all cases where the rates and duties arising on any one Cargo of Articles, upon which the same rates and duties are imposed by the herein-before recited Acts, or either of them, shall exceed the sum of one hundred pounds, bonds shall be taken for securing the payment of the same as follows, to wit, one third in six months, one third in twelve months, and the remaining one third in eighteen months, any thing in the same recited Acts, or any or either of them to the contrary notwithstanding.
