56 George III – Chapter 8

An Act to give two additional Terms in each year for the sittings of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas in the County of Northumberland. Passed the 7th of March, 1816.

Whereas it has become expedient that two additional Terms for the sittings of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas should be held in the County of Northumberland, as in the other Counties of this Province.

- I. Be it enacted by the President, Council and Assembly, That there shall be two additional Terms for the sittings of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the said County of Northumberland, at the following times, viz. on the first Tuesday in June and the first Tuesday in November in each and every year, at which Terms no Jury shall be summoned to attend.
- II. And be it further enacted, That all causes which shall stand continued over, at the next Term of the Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the said County of Northumberland, after the passing of this Act, shall be considered as continued over to the additional Term herein-before mentioned next succeeding, and it shall be lawful for the Justices of the said Inferior Court of Common Pleas, to proceed in the said causes at the said next additional Term in manner as it might have been lawful for such Justices to have proceeded at the next Inferior Court of Common Pleas for the said County had this Act not been made.
