58 George III – Chapter 11

An Act to continue several Acts of the General Assembly, that are near expiring. Passed the 11th March 1818.

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the Fifty-second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, "an Act to impose a duty on certain articles imported into this Province;" an Act made and passed in the Fiftieth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled, "an Act to prevent the destruction of Moose, on the Island of Grand-Manan;" an Act made and passed in the Fiftieth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled, "an Act for the better security of the Navigation of certain Harbours, in the County of Northumberland;" An Act made and passed in the Fifty-sixth year of His Majesty's Reign intituled, "an Act to encourage the Fisheries in this Province;" and also an Act made and passed in the Fifty-seventh year of His Majesty's Reign intituled, "an Act to amend and explain an Act intituled, "an Act, to encourage the Fisheries in this Province," be, and the same Acts are hereby continued and declared to be in force for four years, and from thence to the end of the next Session of the General Assembly.
