59 George III – Chapter 1

An Act to prevent the further Issuing and Circulation of Treasury Notes. Passed the 24th of March, 1819.

Whereas it has been found expedient to prevent the further issuing and circulation of Notes, tender and by virtue of the provisions of an Act made and passed in the fifty-eighth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to provide for punctuality of payment at the Treasury";

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That from and after the passing of this Act, no further payments be made at the Treasury of this Province, in Notes, or any Notes be issued on any account whatever, under and by virtue of the provisions of the herein before recited Act; but that as often hereafter as money shall become due or payable, and Warrants be produced for payment of the same at the Treasury, the Treasurer shall pay the amount of such Warrants in Gold and Silver now in this Treasury or as payments may be made at the same.
