60 George III – Chapter 5

An Act for altering the terms of holding the Court of General Sessions of the Peace, and Interior Court of Common Pleas, in the County of King's. Passed the 20th of March 1820.

Whereas the terms appointed for holding the Courts of General Sessions of the Peace, and Inferior Court of Common Pleas, in the County of King's, have been found inconvenient—For remedy thereof.

I. Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the said Courts shall hereafter be holden on the first Tuesday in January, instead of the first Tuesday in March, in each and every year.

II. And be it further enacted, That no process shall abate, or other business of what nature or kind soever, be discontinued, by reason of the alteration of the said term, but shall, and may be proceeded upon, heard and determined, at the terms herein appointed, in the same manner as they might have been proceeded upon, had no alteration been made.
