2 George IV – Chapter 13

**An Act to repeal an Act intituled “An Act for the further increase of the Revenue of this Province,” and “An Act in addition to an Act, intituled an Act for the further increase of the Revenue of this Province.” Passed the 20th of March, 1821.**

Whereas it is expedient that an Act made and passed in the sixtieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled “An Act for the further increase of the Revenue of this Province,” and “An Act in addition to an Act, intituled an Act for the further increase of the Revenue of this Province,” made and passed in the sixtieth year of the same Reign, should be repealed—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant- Governor, Council and Assembly, That the same Acts be, and they are hereby repealed, saving the right of recovery of any penalties and forfeitures inflicted and incurred under and by virtue of the provisions of the same.
