3 George IV – Chapter 11

An Act further to assess the County of Westmorland, for the completing and finishing the Court House and Gaol in said County. Passed the 21st March, 1822.

Whereas the money already assessed for the erecting a Court House and Gaol in the County of Westmorland, has been insufficient—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That the Justices of the Peace for the said County, at any General Session of the Peace hereafter to be holden, or the major part of them, or at any Special Sessions for that purpose convened and holden, be, and they are hereby authorized and empowered to make a rate and assessment of any sum not exceeding the sum of seven hundred, pounds, as they in their discretion may think necessary, for the completing and finishing the Court House and Gaol in said County, the same sum to be assessed, levied, and collected, and paid, in such proportion and in the same manner as any other County rates can or may be assessed, levied, collected, and paid, by virtue of an Act made and passed in the twenty-sixth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King; George the Third, intituled "An Act for assessing, levying, and collecting County rates," or any other Act hereafter to be made for the like purpose.
