4 George IV – Chapter 13

**An Act to repeal an Act, intituled "An Act for granting bounties on Grain raised in this Province." Passed the 27th March, 1823.**

Whereas it is expedient, that an Act, intituled "An Act for granting bounties on Grain raised in this Province," should be repealed—

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the sixtieth year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Third, intituled "An Act for granting bounties on Grain raised in this Province," be, and the same is hereby repealed: Saving nevertheless, to such persons as shall be entitled to receive the same, all bounties to which they may be entitled for Grain raised during the last season.
