4 George IV – Chapter 5

**An Act to continue an Act, intituled “An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace, in their General Sessions, to establish Ferries in their respective Counties.” Passed the 27th of March, 1823.**

Be it enacted by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the fifty-eighth year of the Reign of King George the Third, intituled “An Act to authorize the Justices of the Peace, in their General Sessions, to establish Ferries in their respective Counties,” be, and the same is hereby continued and declared to be in full force for five years, and from thence to the end of the then next Session of the General Assembly.
