## An Act in addition to an Act, to regulate the exportation of Fish. Passed the 27th March, 1823.

Whereas the Laws now in force for regulating the exportation of Fish, have been found ineffectual for the purposes intended, and it is necessary to make further regulations in addition to the same—,

Be it therefore enacted by the Lieutenant- Governor, Council, and Assembly, That before clearance shall be granted at any of the Naval Offices in this Province, of any Pickled Fish shipped for exportation, the following Oath shall be made by the Owner, Exporter, or Shipper of the said Fish, before the Naval Officer, or his Deputy, at the Port where the said Fish may be shipped for exportation; which Naval Officer or his Deputy, is hereby authorized and required, to administer the same, namely,

I do swear, that all the Pickled Fish shipped by me on board the \_\_\_\_\_\_whereof \_\_\_\_\_\_\_ is Master, are inspected, and in every respect put up agreeably to the Law of this Province, (or if shipped at the Port of Saint John, agreeably to the Law of the Corporation of the City of Saint John) to the best of my knowledge and belief.
