4 George IV – Chapter 8

An Act to repeal an Act, intituled “An Act to increase the Revenue of this Province, by imposing a duty on certain Merchandize.” Passed the 27th March, 1823.

Whereas it is deemed expedient that the “Act to increase the Revenue of this Province, by imposing a duty on certain Merchandize,” should be repealed—

Be it therefore enacted, by the Lieutenant-Governor, Council, and Assembly, that an Act made and passed in the second year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled “An Act to increase the Revenue of this Province, by imposing a duty on certain Merchandise,” be, and the same is hereby repealed.
