

Acts of the General Assembly of His Majesty's Province of New-Brunswick passed in the year 1824. Fredericton, NB: George K. Lugin, Printer to the King's Most Excellent Majesty, 1824.

5 George IV – Chapter 17

An Act to continue and amend an Act, intituled, "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province." Passed 11th March, 1824.

Be it enacted, by the President, Council, and Assembly, That an Act made and passed in the third year of the Reign of His present Majesty, intituled, "An Act for raising a Revenue in this Province" and since continued to the first day of April next, he, and the same is hereby further continued (excepting where the same is hereby amended and altered); and declared to be in full force until the first day of April, which will be in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-five.

II. And be it further enacted, That the short duty only shall be demanded and taken in all cases where the dutiable articles have been altogether purchased with the produce of this Province, and imported into the Province in the same vessel in which such produce of the Province was exported therefrom, although no part of such vessel may be owned therein, as well as in the cases in that behalf specified in the first Section of the said recited Act.
